- B. BOD recognizes the need to host Referee classes, possibly inviting eligible teens
 - 1. Need 20 people to hold class;
 - a. 3 days
 - b. KSC will consider teens for side-referees, not center
 - c. Any interest persons in taking a referee course should contact Amy Pitzer

XVII. New Business/Round table:

- A. Parent Matt Maher inquired about the Club's plans for the spring season regarding the U10 division. He expressed an interest in a more competitive level for the boys this spring.
 - 1. President, Amy Pitzer, communicated that there would be a U9 and U10 academy for the spring 2011 season as it is a great opportunity to develop players for the travel environment.
 - 2. Academy Director, Eric Johanning, stated that he recognized that there were some players currently in the Academy who would be capable of more challenge and noted that plans were being made to address that need.
 - 3. Brenda Olsen and Tracey Stout both commented on the positive experience the Academy has offered their children.
 - 4. Brenda Olsen the Registrar noted that parents should understand that even if a child tries out for a team, it will be at the discretion of the coaching staff and the club whether or not that child is offered a roster spot to play up. Olsen suggests parents need to be aware that it is a try-out and no spot is guaranteed.
